A meeting was convened at the above-mentioned place and venue of the District Level Monitoring Committee today at 4.30 P.M. under the chairmanship of the Hon'ble District & Sessions Judge, Cachar and in presence of the members as mentioned above. In the meeting, the agenda put up for discussion **was "special attempt for execution of the processes relating to old pending case and also as regards the investigation of the cases"**.

In the meeting, the issues, which were discussed, and the resolutions taken on the discussion and agreed upon by all present are written down as follows:-

1) The monitoring committee discussed about issues of the pending cases for investigations and execution of summons. The Additional S.P. has pointed out that due to the ongoing NRC updating process, there is some difficulty in execution of the process.

2) In the meeting, the matter as regards preparation of the sketch map by the I.O. It has been pointed out that some I.O.s have the habit of preparing the sketch maps in the case diary itself and it makes it difficult to exhibit the same and questions are raised regarding its admissibility. The Addl. S.P. has assured that the matter will be communicated to the O/Cs of all the concerned police stations for informing the I.O.s under their jurisdiction.

3) It has also been discussed that NBWAs issued by the court have not been executed recently and proper reports are not sent. The Addl. S.P. has informed that due to the NRC

updating processes, there might have been some slowdown in the processes of execution of the NBWAs and processes but he assured that instructions will be sent for proper execution.

4) The Addl. S.P. has also raised a query as regards execution of warrants in cases wherein the accused or the warrantee is an old and disabled person or pregnant woman and the police faces dilemma and what would the police do in such a situation. It has been discussed that in some extreme cases, the police officials may give reasons for failure to execute the warrants and also furnish supporting documents and inform the courts who would take decisions and pass orders after considering the same.

5) The Additional S.P. has also raised the issue of non-furnishing of the medical documents from the SMCH authorities which has prevented them from filing charge sheets in many cases. The Superintendent, SMCH has asked the police officials to submit the details of the injured persons like their names and dates when sent for medical requisition if their hospital numbers or MRD numbers are not available. It has been decided that the police officials would send the details in a format and the Superintendent, SMCH would look into the matter and have the reports made available as early as possible.

The meeting ended with a formal vote of thanks.
