

MINUTES OF THE MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF MARCH, 2017 HELD ON 28.03.2017
AT 4.15 P.M. AT THE OFFICE CHAMBER OF THE DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE,
CACHAR, SILCHAR.

The D.C Cachar, is represented by the A.D.C. The S.P., Cachar is un-represented, The S.P Hailakandi is represented by the Additional S.P., the officers including the Member, M.A.C.T., the Counsellor, Family Court, the representative of the Joint Director, Health Services, Cachar, the learned C.J.M. and other judicial officers are present to discuss the agenda of revised action plan about special attempt for executing processes relating to old pending cases.

During the discussion, a point taken up for discussion was the problems faced by the courts to peruse the notes and the noting entered in the FIR or behind the same like the G.D. entry etc. as the same gets damaged due to they being written on the corners. To remove the said problem, it has desired that the Police Authorities would take necessary steps to inform all the O/C concerned of various police stations that they would ensure that the noting are made in the middle of the page and not to be dragged to the corners of the page.

During the discussion, the representative from the S.P., Hailakandi has submitted a list of cases which are pending investigation due to delay in receiving the medical and injury reports of from the S.M.C.H. authorities. A list of 31 such cases are put up but as none from the SMCH, Silchar are present, they cannot be informed of the same. It has been decided that the District Administration, Cachar would take up the matter with the SMCH authorities and they would try to expedite the process of sending the injury reports of the cases. A list of the cases may be handed over to the A.D.C, Cachar for his necessary action.

It has been also discussed that that the Seizure Witnesses at the time of adducing evidence tends to resile from the prosecution case and states that they were not aware as to why their signatures were taken. It has been pointed out that the I.O.s could ensure that the witnesses are mentioned of the procedure and also a note may be given in the end stating that the signature was put after reading over the matter and after ascertaining the contents. It was also pointed out that is situations when seizures could not be taken up in place of occurrence, the same may be noted in the C.D. and reflected in the Seizure List.

All the officers expressed their satisfaction about the serving and execution of process of the Court by the police.

During the discussion, a point taken up for discussion was the problems faced by the Civil Courts as regards the receipt of the Saham report (Circle Officer Report) after drawing the preliminary decree. It has been pointed out that reports are pending from the office of the Circle Office of various Circles have not sent reports since 2004 and even though the orders of the court has been forwarded from the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Cachar. It is urged upon the representative of the District Administration to take up the matter with the concerned officers. The presiding officers of the Civil Courts are also asked to prepare a list of the cases where reports are awaited.


During the discussion, another miscellaneous issue as regards the disposal of the old and damaged vehicle which are lying in the different complexes of the court and residential quarters. It has been urged that the District Administration may take up the matter for auctioning the various vehicles to clear the space.

As regards the execution of process, the officers at Cachar have expressed their satisfaction.
