

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 2016 WITH
DISTRICT MAGISTRATE AND SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HELD ON
29.11.2016 AT 4-30 P.M. AT THE OFFICE CHAMBER OF
THE DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, CACHAR, SILCHAR.**

In the monthly meeting is held with District Magistrate represented by the D.D.C, Cachar, Superintendent of Police and District Judge, along with other Judicial Officers. In the meeting some points regarding investigation of the cases are discussed.

During the discussion, a point is raised as regards the submitting of charge sheet on time in serious cases. It was discussed that the I.O. should not wait for FSL reports or other technical investigation reports and file the C.S. on time. It has been discussed that in serious cases, the I.O. may not wait for the arrest of all the accused persons and may even file the charge sheet showing the accused persons as absconders after following the due procedure as per law.

It was also discussed in cases wherein the offences are found at the time of filing of charge sheet to be minor ones than the ones under which registered, then the I.O. and the concerned O/C should ensure that the charge sheet are forwarded on time to the P.S.I, office specially in cases wherein the accused persons are detained in jail.


In the discussion, it was again urged that the email addresses and the mobile phone numbers of the official witnesses are kept in the C.D., with their full names and addresses.


It was also discussed that in cases wherein Prosecution Sanction is required to be filed along with the C.D, the copy of the Sanction Letter may also be kept with the C.D. after comparing the same with the original.

During the discussion, it was felt necessary that training may be imparted to the police officers with regard the investigation in cases under NDPS Act and it was suggested that the qualified customs officials may be requested to impart the same and the S.P may do the needful.



The S.P. has assured that he will look into the matter and it has been decided that the process should be addressed through the office of the DGP, Assam.


The Additional Sessions Judge (FTC) also raised the issue of failure on part of few I.O.s to submit the C.Ds on time whenever called for and it was assured by the S.P, that he will ensure that the I.O. submit the C.Ds on time or at least inform the courts for failure to do so.
