**CACHAR, SILCHAR.**





**MINUTES OF THE MEETING FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST, 2017 WITH DISTRICT  
MAGISTRATE AND SUPERINTENDENTS OF POLICE HELD ON 25.08.17 AT 4-15 P.M.  
AT THE OFFICE CHAMBER OF THE DISTRICT & SESSIONS JUDGE, CACHAR, SILCHAR.**

The D.C Cachar, is represented by the A.D.C. The S.P, Cachar is represented by the Addl. S.P, The S.P. Karimganj is represented by Dy. S.P., Karimganj, the deputy Superintendent, SMCH, the representative of the Joint Director, Health Services, Cachar, the member M.A.C.T, the C.J.M. and other judicial officers are present to discuss the agenda regarding investigation of the cases are discussed.

During the discussion, a point is raised as regards the submitting of injury reports by the doctors concerned. It has suggested that the medical officers who examine the victims may send the copies of the X-Ray reports and reports of Radiological examination with the medical reports submitted and the I.O. should also ensure that all reports be collected. It has been assured that the Department of Forensic Medicine are entrusted with the examination of the victims/person who are sent for their ossification tests and for determination of their age will be able to send the x-ray report with the test report.

It was also discussed that in serious cases, where due to the lapses of the of the investigation agencies, the cases have resulted in acquittal, the police officials have asked that copies of such judgments are sent to the police officials for their study and improvement. In this regard, the police department is asked to engage the public prosecutors to identify the cases and assist the courts in determining the cases.

A view is also taken that any prescriptions from the hospital authority shall be issued not on loose sheets or private letter but on prescribed form having seal and date and sl. number.

The Joint Director of Health Services has been requested to ensure that communications are made to the doctors that all medical reports are made legibly and not behind the requisition slips.

The I.O. will also ensure that they would make every efforts to collect the final injury reports along with the initial examination report if any.


It is desired that all the stake holders expressed that in case of transfer of medical officers who prepared the injury reports; in his place any other doctors who is conversant with the handwriting and the signature of the said doctor may be deputed on case of any orders is passed by the court and the Hospital authority shall mention the name of the doctor and his identity and address who may be summoned by the court.

It has been discussed that during investigation, the seizure list is to be prepared properly and if witnesses are not available, then mention is to be made as to why the same was prepared in other place or in police station.
