JUDGE, CACHAR, SILCHAR.**



The D.C Cachar, is absent. The S.P., Cachar is represented by Dy S.P., the officers including the Member, M.A.C.T., the C.J.M. and other judicial officers are present to discuss the agenda regarding investigation of the cases are discussed.

During the meeting, the highlights of the training programme attended by the Grade I judicial officers of Assam and organized by the Assam Judicial Academy were pointed out by the District & Sessions Judge and the role of the police and the courts has been discussed.

The matter of registering of cases and sending of the A.I.R. by the police has also been discussed. In cases of accident, the police authorities have been asked to see the viability of sending the extract copy of the 1st G.D. Entry registered along with the FIR when the same are sent to the court for being shown to the Magistrates.

It was also discussed that in serious cases, especially cases under POSCO Act and for sexual related offences, when the age of the victim cannot be ascertained, the I.O. would consider the age of the victim as recorded in the medical report while taking up the investigation.
