


Sir,

With reference to above, it is to inform you that prior to the issuance of SOP, list of cases punishable upto 3 years or fine registered upto 14.08.2022 excluding certain categories of cases mentioned in the SOP were called for from the District Judiciary office and accordingly the soft copies of the same with court wise case details received from all the Districts.

On verification of the lists it was noticed that in some of the list, private complaint cases like NI Act and Domestic Violence Act cases and in some list cases beyond the SOP are included.

Further, during the Cabinet meeting, decision was taken to exclude the cases registered u/s 498A/PC and dowry cases.

The soft copies of the list so received are being sent to the respective Deputy Commissioner with a request to provide the soft copy as well as the hard copies of the list pertaining to their District to their respective Public Prosecutor.

You are hereby requested to correct the list by removing / deleting / striking off the cases mentioned above and not covered by the SOP and provide the same to your respective District Judge with a request to get it uploaded in the District Judiciary website and hang the hard copies in the Notice Board of the District & Session Judge and Chief Judicial Magistrate. Further the hard copy of the list pertaining to the particular court may also be hanged outside that court in the notice board or appropriate place for better convenience and notice of the litigants.

Sub: Authority letter for withdrawal of petty/minor criminal cases u/s
Section 321 Cr.PC.

Sir,

In pursuance of the Cabinet Decision held on 11.09.2022 and as per SOP issued vide Notification No.E.217405/52 dated 21.10.2022, the Public Prosecutor, Additional Public Prosecutor and Assistant Public Prosecutor of all districts in Assam are hereby authorized to file application under Section 321 Cr.PC before their respective Courts for withdrawal of petty/minor pending criminal cases that are covered under the policy/SOP i.e. cases where punishment is upto 3(three) years of fine under the Indian Penal Code or any other Special Act / Regulations registered upto 14.08.2022 except the following categories of cases:

- i. Molestation/ Sexual Assault /POCSO Act.
- ii. Corruption /embezzlement of public fund.
- iii. NDPS Act.
- iv. Arms Act/Explosive Substance Act.
- v. Cases registered under Section 498(A) IPC and other cases related to dowry.
- vi. 304 A IPC/Vehicle theft cases U/S 379 IPC.
- vii. Offence relating to coins and Government stamp/Currency.
- viii. Unlawful Activities (P) Act.
- ix. Organized Crimes like cattle smuggling / supari smuggling / coal smuggling / oil theft etc.
- x. Cases against MPs & MLAs.
